

Beginner Drawing and Painting Course

Duration:
96 Hours
4 Months

This course is specially designed for beginners, hobby artists, and students who have little or no prior experience in art. The program focuses on building a strong artistic foundation by improving observation skills, hand control, and understanding of form, light, and colour.

Throughout the course, students are gradually introduced to drawing, colouring, and basic portrait creation. Step by step, they learn essential techniques that help them develop confidence in their artistic abilities and prepare them for more advanced art studies.

MEDIUMS COVERED

Students will get hands-on experience with a variety of artistic mediums, including:

Drawing Fundamentals

In the beginning, students learn the essential basics of drawing and materials.

- > Introduction to art tools, different types of paper, and proper material handling
- > Practice of line quality, pressure control, and stroke techniques
- > Understanding basic shapes and learning how to convert them into forms
- > Introduction to light sources, highlights, mid-tones, and shadows
- > Simple object drawing to improve observation and accuracy

Object Drawing, Perspective and Shading

This section focuses on adding depth and realism to drawings.

- > Graphite shading techniques
- > Creating depth using tonal values
- > Basic introduction to perspective
- > Still life compositions with single and multiple objects

Color Theory & Painting Basics

Students are introduced to the fundamentals of color and painting techniques.

- > Understanding the color wheel and color harmony
- > Color mixing techniques using oil pastels and poster colors
- > Blending, layering, and detailing with color pencils
- > Introduction to basic watercolor techniques
- > Creating landscapes and nature-inspired color compositions

Basic Portrait and Composition

In the final stage of the course, students learn the fundamentals of portrait drawing and composition.

- > Introduction to human face proportions
- > Understanding facial structures such as eyes, nose, lips and ears
- > Studying light and shadow on the face
- > Basic pencil portrait drawing
- > Simple composition principles
- > A final guided artwork combining all the techniques learned during the course
