

# Special Interest Art Courses

These courses are designed for students who wish to move beyond the hobby stage and develop their skills as confident and professional artists. They are ideal for learners who already have some basic experience and want to explore art more seriously.

The programs are interest-based and goal-oriented, allowing students to choose a specific art form that appeals to them. This focused approach helps participants gain deeper knowledge and practical skills in their chosen medium.

## Traditional Indian Art Workshops

These workshops are short and intensive, usually conducted over 2–3 days or during weekends. They provide a wonderful opportunity to explore traditional Indian art forms in a hands-on and engaging way.

### Madhubani (Mithila Art)

- > Uses double-line drawing techniques filled with intricate patterns
- > Common motifs include fish, peacocks, flowers and the Tree of Life
- > Can be created on paper, fabric (such as tote bags) or wooden trays

### Lippan Art

- > Creating raised patterns using clay or texture paste
- > Carving designs while the surface is still wet
- > Embedding mirrors to create traditional reflective designs

### Mandala Art

- > Designing circular geometric patterns
- > Creating radial symmetry using grids, compasses and protractors
- Developing patience, concentration and detailed pattern work

## Modern Decorative Art Forms

### Resin Art

- > Resin mixing and safety practices
- > Pouring techniques and color blending
- > Creating smooth and glossy finishes

### Oil Painting

- > Color mixing techniques for beginners
- > Brush handling and control
- > Shading, texture creation and blending
- > Basic compositions and still life painting

## Acrylic Painting

- > Color mixing and layering techniques
- > Brush application and paint textures
- > Shading and highlights
- > Still life and decorative compositions

## Calligraphy & Hand Lettering

- > **Calligraphy:** Focuses on structured and traditional letterforms with consistent strokes.
- > **Hand Lettering:** Involves creatively drawing letters in unique artistic styles.

## Modern Brush Lettering

- > Learning light and heavy strokes using brush pens
- > Creating stylish alphabets and decorative lettering

## Composition & Flourishing

- > Learning to arrange words and quotes in visually appealing layouts
- > Adding decorative swirls, flourishes and embellishments
- > Creating artistic quote designs and lettering artworks

## Art Therapy & Stress Relief

### Fluid Art (Acrylic Pouring)

- > Free-flow painting technique using poured acrylic paints
- > Encourages creative freedom and spontaneous patterns
- > A relaxing method that allows artists to let go of control and enjoy the process

## Texture Painting

- > Using heavy acrylic paints and modeling paste
- > Creating tactile, touchable textured artworks
- > Exploring depth and surface effects in painting
